## **Conclusions**

- > Ranking within groups remained constant between the pre-matching and post-matching cohort.
- > Both pre-matching and post-matching:
  - Males have higher dropout rates and lower ECTS than females.
  - Students with a prior education in MBO have higher dropout rates and lower ECTS compared to HAVO and VWO.
  - Native students have lower dropout rates and higher ECTS compared to other ethnicities.
- > The three largest differences in dropout between pre- and post-matching are seen in MBO, VWO and non-western ethnic minority students.
  - Decline in dropout of MBO and non-western ethnic minority students.
  - Increase in dropout of VWO students, however they comprise a small group.
